Spring is in the air and it is wonderful to see all the bulbs popping up adding colour to our verges. The field is also buzzing with new plants thanks to our wonderful volunteers.

Our Highways - We have finally had resurfacing throughout the whole village, unfortunately patched and not a total resurface but still a massive improvement. If you notice any reoccurrence of pot holes please report immediately on the DMBC website.

Parking - please ask visitors to be considerate when parking in the village, don't park on pavements to allow pushchairs and wheelchair access.

The Village Field - located behind Denaby Lane, volunteers have been out in force cutting away the overgrown grasses and plants, bench bases have been uncovered and new wood is being cut to size ready for installation. We are also installing some playground equipment onto the field shortly

Keep Old Denaby Tidy - We are putting a lot of time, effort and money into developing the village field for our community. Please pick up after your dogs and dispose of it in the bins provided at the exit of the field.

Street Drainage - we are in constant communication with regard to the blocked drains within our village and have recently had a team out to inspect and clear drains up to Ferryboat Lane.
